**Department Presentation** – Police Department – Chief Dudik Presenting

The year 2013 has been a real treat for management regarding audits. The Police Department had 2 LEADs audits. A Technical Audit in June. With the help of Suite 224, the Police Department made it through the audit. In July the Police Department had a Records Audit of the Dispatch Center. The City had no errors and was in 100% compliance.

The State of Ohio has hired more people and this year the City had a Jail Inspection. The inspection was a six hour process. The Physical Jail was in good shape. The Police Department has several policies that must be updated, one of which is a physical inspection every sixty minutes, cannot use the camera. The City does not have enough corrections officers to accomplish this. The Police Department has three weeks to come up with a plan. Overall Geneva did very well. The Police Department will try to work on areas that need to be improved.

Mike Miller will be replacing Joe Carroll.

The Police Department has brought on three new part-time officers; Courtney Burt, Brad Frederick and Randy Poor.

Officer Hutchins is back to work. Officer Hutchins had been off from November of last year to July. Officer Hutchins is having twins at the end of the year and will be on FMLA at the end of the year.

The Police Department has less than 10% of its overtime budget remaining.

In August the City Police Department partnered with other law enforcement on a sobriety checkpoint. It was a small operation. Two OVI's were issued in the first half hour.

Dispatch is coordinating with the County on the updating of software and hardware.
