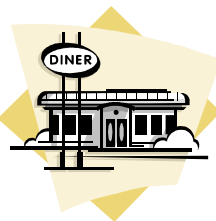

## Free Services Offered

- ❖ Prescription Assistance for Seniors (PAS) has saved seniors millions of dollars since its inception in FREE or discounted prescriptions from pharmaceutical companies.
- ❖ Transportation – GASC provides free transportation to seniors within the Geneva Area School District. **We are wheelchair accessible.**
- ❖ Medical Assessment – We offer regular blood pressure and blood sugar tests as well as occasional balance and hearing tests.
- ❖ Medical Equipment Lending.
- ❖ Medical Forums on a range of topics from Alzheimer's to X-rays.
- ❖ Informational Forums.
- ❖ Computer and Internet Service.
- ❖ Copy and Fax (free or small donation suggested).
- ❖ Handyman Program – Need a light changed, but feel unsteady on a ladder? Have a leaky faucet? Call us and we'll arrange to have it taken care of for the cost of the materials.
- ❖ Yard Work and other home projects – Through a local Church we have volunteers that can help you.
- ❖ Forms, such as the Heating Energy Assistance Program, Buckeye Card, Living Wills, Medical Power of Attorney, and others.
